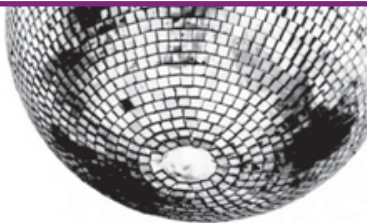
This morning your child has met their new teacher and the teaching assistant that they will be working with in September. I am sure they will tell you all about it this weekend.
