Dear Parent

Year 5 Residential Trips to Aylmerton on 19-22 March 2010 & Barton Turf Sailing July 2010.

We are writing to let you know that we offer two residential trips to Year 5 pupils. The first is a long weekend to Aylmerton Field Study Centre in Norfolk which we hope everyone will attend. Here the children get the chance to further their Rivers topic by studying the river Glaven and Blakeney marshes and dunes – stopping to visit the seals! They will also be trying different pirate activities such as the low ropes and zip wire. There will be many other activities to make a very busy weekend!

The second is a trip to Barton Turf to sail on the broads, for those who wish to develop and improve their sailing skills (following the opportunity to sail after school at Cheshunt in the summer term). For your information the cost of Barton this year (2009) is approximately £225 and we anticipate the 2010 costs will prove to be similar. Further information on Barton will be sent home during the autumn term.

We have booked the Aylmerton centre for the weekend of the 19th- 22nd March 2010; the cost will be approximately £135, depending on the number of children and staff attending. In order to secure the provisional booking, we require **a non-refundable deposit of £40.00 to be paid by Monday 7th September 2009.**

Please complete and return the tear off slip below together with a £40 deposit if you wish to secure a place on the Year 5 Aylmerton residential journey. Cheques should be made payable to Morgans Primary School. A payment card will be issued and a suggested payment timetable for the remaining £95 is given below. You are, of course, welcome to make payments at other times to suit your circumstances but the balance must be paid in full by **Friday 8th January 2010** to allow the school to make the required scheduled payments to Aylmerton. Any payments received after this deadline will incur an additional £5 administration fee.

We need to ask you for this voluntary contribution to cover the cost of the trip, which includes 50p as your annual insurance payment for off-site visits.
